## 2021 SUMMER PROJECTS/RETURNING RESIDENCY COVID-19 POLICIES UPDATED JULY 21, 2021



## **VACCINE REQUIREMENT- NEW**

• Residents must be fully vaccinated (two doses of either the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine or a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine) at least 14 days prior to arrival and with no Covid-19 symptoms

• Negative test no longer accepted in lieu of vaccine card, except for children 12 or under. Children under 12 are required to wear masks outdoors in crowded areas where social distancing cannot be maintained and indoors in public spaces.

• A photocopy of vaccine card must be emailed to FAWC at least 14 days prior to arrival

• If a household member accompanies the resident for the Residency (see Guest policy below), the same proof of vaccine requirements apply

- Failure to provide proof within the time frame stated above will result in a forfeiture of Residency, including payment

#### **COVID-19 WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

Resident must sign and submit the <u>Covid-19 Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement</u> no later than 14 days prior to arrival
If a household member accompanies the resident for the Residency (see Guest policy below), they too must sign and submit

the Covid-19 Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement no later than 14 days prior to arrival

• Failure to submit the Agreement within the time frame stated above will result in a forfeiture of Residency, including payment

#### **COVID-19 SYMPTOMS, HEALTH SERVICES**

• If resident, or accompanying household member (see Guest policy below), develops Covid-19 symptoms while in residence at FAWC, they must self-quarantine until able to provide a new negative PCR test

## MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING
